


## **Phase 1 Improvements**





### **Existing Conditions**

- 0.5 mile corridor
- 5-lane minor arterial roadway
- Transit route
- No bike lanes
- Serves residential, religious institutions, and Glassbrook Elementary School
- Daily Traffic of 12,500 vpd
- 85<sup>th</sup> percentile speed of 35mph





# **Collision Data Analysis**

Date	# of Collisions	Due to
2019	3	Following too closely, Improper Turning, and Driving Under Influence
2020	l h	Unsafe Speed, Traffic Signal, and Pedestrian Right-of-Way Violation
2021	l 5	Unsafe Speed, Improper Turning, and Pedestrian Right-of-way Violation
2022	I <b>≺</b>	Unsafe Speed, Improper Turning, Auto Right-of-Way Violation
2023	6	Unsafe Speed, Unsafe Lane Change, and Pedestrian Right-of-Way Violation

#### **Benefits of Road Diet**


- Reduce speeding and calms traffic
- Reduce left-turn lane conflicts
- Reduce weaving and lane change collisions
- Reduces the # of lanes for peds to cross
- Meets the needs of all users: auto, transit, ped, cyclists


