SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

BRANDISHING A WEAPON: On 04/28/2024 at 2:52 PM, officers responded to the report of a man brandishing a metal pole near the 27000 block of Hesperian Blvd, where witnesses stated he was smashing car windows.
