

NOTICE TO TENANTS ABOUT RIGHT TO PERMANENT RELOCATION ASSISTANCE

This form is not intended to take the place of a formal notice to terminate tenancy. It is intended to accompany a notice to terminate tenancy.

The City of Hayward's Tenant Relocation Assistance Ordinance (TRAO) requires that landlords provide relocation assistance to tenants for no-fault eviction. This notice is to inform you that your household is entitled to permanent relocation assistance.
