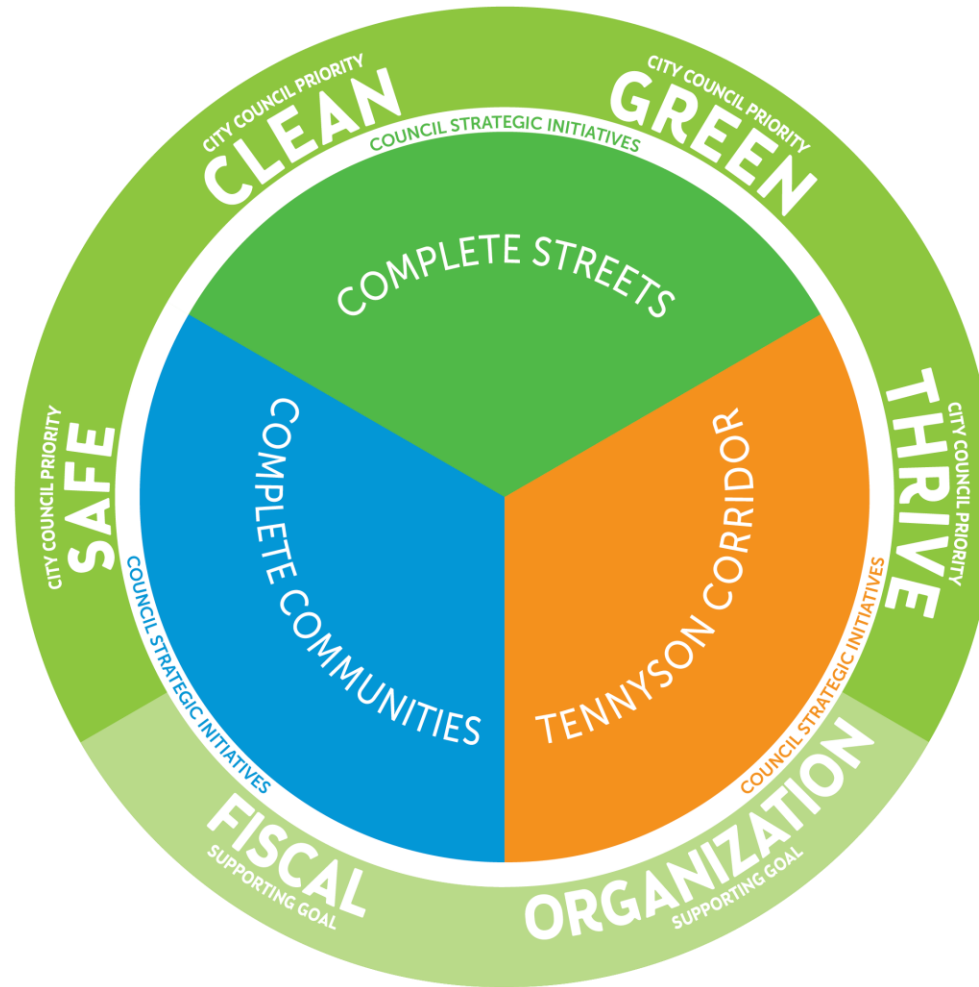

❖ **Purpose:** To develop an attractive, cohesive, thriving Tennyson Corridor through thoughtful engagement of residents, businesses, and community partnerships.

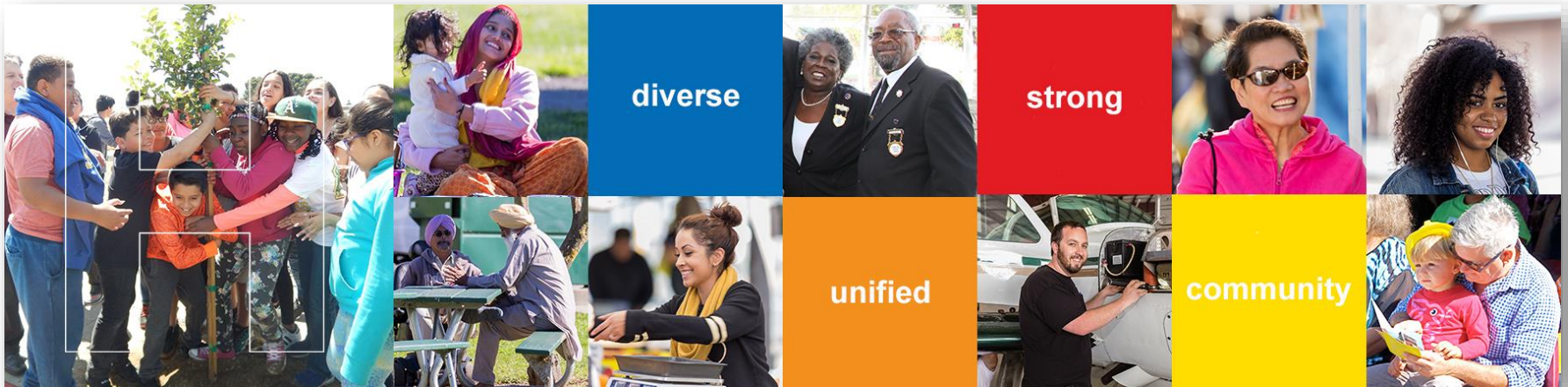


COMPLETE STREETS STRATEGIC INITIATIVE

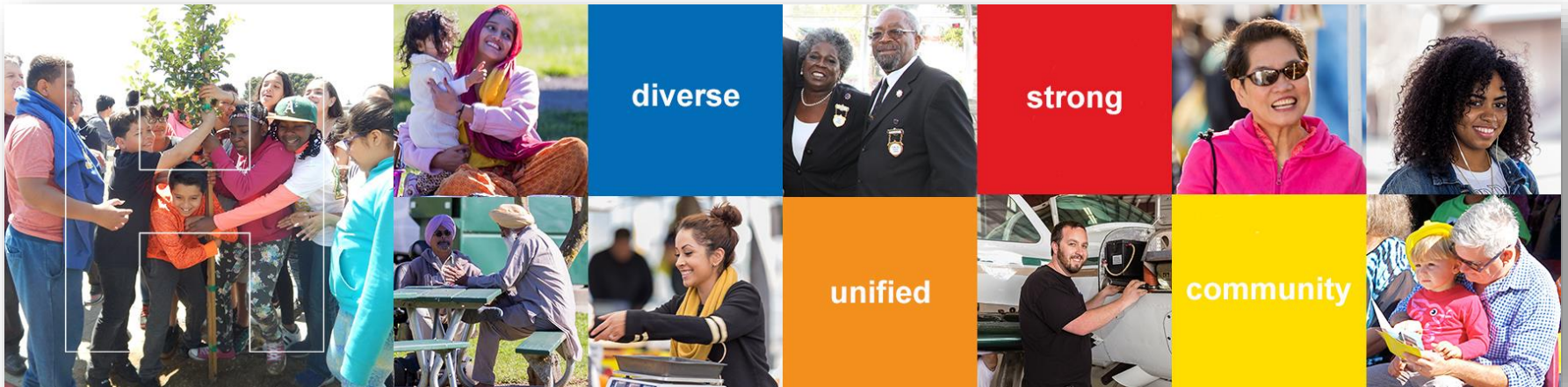
