WHAT IS HOP AND WHO IS IT FOR?

HOP stands for **Hayward Operated Paratransit** – and it's here to help you get around!

If you live in **Hayward**, **San Lorenzo**, **Castro Valley**, or **unincorporated San Leandro**, you may be eligible for this **reliable**, **affordable transportation** service run by the City of Hayward.

Who can use HOP?

- If you're **70 or older**, you qualify!
- If you're **18+ with a disability** that makes it hard to drive, you can qualify too.

Whether it's a doctor's appointment, a visit with friends, or a trip to the store — HOP makes it easier to get there.

New Service Starting May 12: Companion Rides! A Helping Hand When You Need It

Getting out and about just got easier! Beginning May 12, HOP is launching our new **Companion Ride Service** — a more supportive option than UBER or Lyft.



What's a Companion Ride?

It's a **Door-Through-Door ride**, where your driver gives you a hand from your front door into the car — and into your destination on the other end.

Companion Drivers are:

- ✓ CPR & First Aid Certified
- Fingerprinted and Drug Tested
- ✓ Trained to give extra help

They can help with **foldable walkers and wheelchairs**, and if you really like your driver, you can even **ask for them again!**

Can you stand and pivot, but need help getting into or out of a vehicle?

OR

Do you have a medical device, foldable wheelchair, or walker?
