Operational Procedures for All Jet Aircraft

Stage II Jet Operations:

Due to its close proximity to residential areas, the City of Hayward requests your cooperation in **reducing aircraft noise.** The City requires that pure jet aircraft, namely Lear 20-series jets and other Stage II jet aircraft such as the Gulfstream II and III, follow published operating procedures.

Any flight activities of **Stage II jet aircraft** require **prior coordination with Airport Management** by calling

Stage II jet aircraft operating under "Lifeguard" status should contact airport management as soon as possible. Request for Emergency Lifeguard Flight Information form.

If the Airport Office is closed at that time, the PIC should leave a Voice Mail message at 510-293-5462, providing the aircraft N-number and a contact telephone number.

Stage III Jet Operations:

Stage III jet aircraft operations do not require prior coordination.

Stage III jets commonly operating at Hayward are:

- Beechjet 400
- British Aerospace Hawkers (all)
- Canadair Challengers 600 and 601
- Cessna Citations (all)
- Dassault Breguet
- Falcon series 10, 20-C5/D5/E5/F5, 50, 200, 900 and 2000
- Gulfstream IV (medium TOW)
- HS-125 series with TFE engines
- IAI Westwind 1124 and 1125
- Lear 30 series and up
- Mitsubishi MU-300
- Sabreliner 65.

While there are other Stage III jets that can operate at Hayward, an aircraft's operating handbook usually confirms its Stage III status.
