




Main Street Typical Section

Main Street Enhancements- N. of A St.




- Sidewalk, Pavement and Striping Improvements
- Work completed by Main and Maple Developer
- Maintains existing traffic capacity, but slows vehicle speeds
- Provides a Class II bicycle lane through the corridor


Main Street Enhancements- A to C St.



- Improves the pedestrian experience with new decorative sidewalks and bulb-outs from A to C Streets
- Improves pavement
- Maintains existing traffic capacity, but slows vehicle speeds
- Provides a Class II bicycle lane through the corridor
- Maintains existing streetlights, adds pedestrian scale lighting, maintains existing trees and add new street trees
- Maintains AC Transit stop at B Street



Main Street Enhancements – A Street




- Bulb-outs at intersection promote pedestrian safety and create zones for landscaping

 - Planting areas in bulb-outs





Main Street Enhancements – B Street






Crosswalk Treatment

- Changes four lanes to two lanes for east bound C Street and Main Street

Main Street Enhancements - C to D St.



- Maintains existing traffic capacity, but slows vehicle speeds
- Provides a Class II bicycle lane through the corridor
- Layout is approved by Hayward Fire Department
