SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

COMMUNITY PROJECT: On 8/6/2025 at 7:00 AM The City of Hayward (COH) conducted a comprehensive street cleanup near Belvedere Court through the coordinated efforts of the COH Streets Division, Landscaping Services, Code Enforcement, and District Command.
